WHAT DO WE DO?




- We promote & protect British music at home and abroad, in collaboration with IFPI.

YOY growth in the past 10 years.





Predominance of bootlegs.


Vinyl just under a half.

RAIDS

13 raids executed in H1 2023.

117k units seized, between CDs & vinyl.

Minimum of £1.17M worth of fake product removed from the market







INVESTIGATING FAKE VINYL

Internet best starting point to identify unofficial releases, particularly sites like Discogs

Test purchases to confirm suspicions & track origin



FAKE VINYL TYPOLOGIES & IDENTIFIERS



- We find counterfeit, bootleg, & pirate titles.
- Hybrid releases with one original track & several remixes, often with artwork taken from an original release.
- Coloured vinyl & picture discs.
- We can tell they are fake from the condition of the items, absence of standard information on the packaging, quality of printing, quality of pressing, sound quality, price.
- This across heritage acts & current mainstream artists.





FAKE VINYL ECOSYSTEM

MANUFACTURERS:

- Organised Crime Groups (OCGs)
- Underground pressing plants
- Semi-legitimate pressing plants

• LOCATIONS:

- Eastern & Western Europe (Russia, Germany, UK)
- o US


DISTRIBUTION:

 Individuals & record stores buy their stock from the manufacturers (sometimes not knowing it's fake) and resell it through the regular channels



OP REDWOOD: NORTHERN SOUL 7"RECORDS





- 7" vinyl recordings of 1960's Northern Soul artists, including collectibles worth thousands of pounds.
- Case centred around 4 sellers based across England & Wales.
- They were both manufacturing & selling the items online.
- 55,000 unlicensed records seized.
- A 6 year-long investigation resulted in 4 convictions, 5 years' worth of prison sentences & £1.3M in fines.



OP HUTTER: COUNTERFEIT VINYL ON EBAY







- Complaint from member of the public about a counterfeit The Clash LP (poor sound quality).
- The seller, Mr Richard Hutter, had almost 1,200 fake LPs listed for sale on eBay.
- Over £1.2M worth of fake product seized from his home address.
- Hutter sentenced with a £380k fine or 3 years imprisonment.
